## **Conditions of issue**

- 1. Places on any SWEDSWA basic dry stone walling course will be subject to availability.
- 2. Gift Certificates are valid for three years from the date of issue.
- 3. No refunds if you fail to attend your selected course, unless more than four week's notice has been received.
- 4. Transfers to other courses available if sufficient notice of not less than four weeks is given.

Candidates must be a minimum of 18 years old when attending the course.

Personal data provided on the application form will be retained until a review takes place in October of all the courses, except we will keep a record of your name to enable us to record that you have attended a SWEDSWA basic course. Other than this, all personal data will be deleted from our records unless you become a member of the association.
